
Barrow County School System School Nutrition Program is proud to be participating in **Farmers Market Fridays** serving Georgia crops and celebrating local farmers.



Georgia's **warm climate** is perfect for growing sweet potatoes.


Sweet potatoes are a popular **Thanksgiving** side dish.
