


Eggs





The U.S. is the **LARGEST** producer, consumer & exporter of corn in the world.



90 MILLION acres of corn is harvested each year in the U.S.



Corn is considered a **vegetable**, **fruit** AND a **grain!**

Most countries outside of the United States calls corn "maize".

Most of the corn grown in the U.S. is grown in what is called the "corn belt" located in the Midwest.



The U.S. produces around 110 BILLION pounds of eggs per year.



Components of an Egg:

- 1. Eggshell
- 2. Egg White (Albumen)
- 3. Egg Yolk (Vitellus)



Eggs with **brown** shells come from larger hens.

One hen can lay around **250** eggs per year.





Eggshells in stores are commonly white or brown, but they can also be blue, green or pink!







Breed of hen determines the shell color.



Connecticut produces around **430 MILLION pounds** of milk per year.

Connecticut is home to around 18,500 dairy cows.

Nearly 98% of U.S. dairy farms are family owned & operated.

Holstein cows all have a unique pattern of spots!

1 cow produces around6 gallons of milk per day.

The reason milk is white is because it contains "casein" - a type of protein.
