Most pears grown in Texas are grown in the **northern** part of the state.



**3,000+** varieties of pears.

Pears used to be called "butter fruit" because of their soft texture.

Common types of pears: **Anjou**, **Bartlett**, **Bosc**, **Comice** & **Forelle**.

#### BUTTER

Pear tree **wood** is often used to make musical instruments.

Pears ripen best **after** they are picked.

Pear trees grow to be **30-40 ft.** tall.





Pears prefer to grow in **cooler climates**.

Pears are a part of the **rose** family.



Pears are considered to be the most fragile fruit.



**ALL** pears are picked by **HAND**.

The U.S. produces **250** million bushels of apples each year.

2,500

varieties of apples are grown in the United States.

Gala apples are currently the most popular apple in the U.S.

An **apple blossom** is the flower that comes from an apple tree.

An apple tree takes at least **4 years** to start producing fruit.

Most apples are HAND-PICKED.

Grow 18 different varieties of apples.





English peas are also referred to as **"garden peas."** 

3 Main Types of Peas:

Throughout the U.S. there are about **893,000 acres** of peas.

1. English Pea

2. Snow Pea

3. Sugar Snap Pea

When a pea pod is **ripe**, the pod will split in half.

Pea pods grow to be around **4 inches** long.

The average pea weighs

0.1 - 0.3

grams!



There are **5 - 10** peas in each pod.

A fully mature pea is actually yellow.

Harvesting usually takes place 60 - 70 days after planting.
