

Virginia is home to **16,000 acres** of apples.

Virginia harvests **5 - 6 BILLION bushels** of apples each year.

Crown Orchards is spread out over a **15-mile radius**.

Crown Orchards also grows **nectarines** & **peaches**.

Sweet Potatoes


In the 1600s, Virginia became the **first** state in the U.S. to grow sweet potatoes.

A root vegetable.




2.5 BILLION pounds of sweet potatoes

String beans

Green bean growing season in Virginia spans from **late spring** through **early fall**.



irginia

Bush beans are the most commonly grown green bean in Virginia.

Green beans are the **3rd most** homegrown vegetable. 130+ varieties of green beans.

Green beans are also known as **"string beans"** or **"snap beans."**

> The World's Tallest Bean Plant was over **45 feet tall**.

Equivalent to **3 fullygrown** giraffes stacked on top of one another.

C & E Farms

C&E Farms was founded in **1986** & the **first** farm to **hydro-cool** their green beans.

Hydro-cooling is when a crop is **submerged** in **VERY cold water** after they are harvested.

C & E Farms was founded by Phil Colson & Lester Erlemeier.

C & E Farms harvests **750,000+ bushels** of green beans each year.



Asian Pears

Asian pears grown in Virginia are in season from **August** - **November**.





Asian pears are native to Japan & China.

Over **3,000** varieties of pears.

Pears ripen best **after** they are picked.

Asian pears have a **unique shape** that resembles an **apple**.


Each pear is inspected **THREE** times during their growing season.
