Cucumbers







Michigan grows over **86 MILLION pounds** of sweet corn each year.

All 50 states grow sweet corn – find some at your local farmer's market!

In many other countries, corn is called **"maize**."

Only **1%** of the corn grown in the U.S. is sweet corn.


Corn is considered a **grain**, **fruit** & **vegetable**.



Nearly **10,000 acres** of sweet corn is grown in Michigan.

An ear of corn ALWAYS has an even number of rows.

> Sweet corn is in *peak* season from **May – Sept**.



Around **800** kernels on each ear of corn.

Sweet corn is the **ONLY** corn grown for **human** consumption.

Sweet corn is pollinated by the **wind**.

Each stalk produces 1 - 3 ears of corn.



Hulett Farms is a **family owned** & **operated** farm known for their **sweet corn**.

Hulett Farms is owned by **Todd Hulett**- also known as **"The Corn Man"**.

Todd Hulett started selling corn in **1980**.

Hulett Farms **farm market** is open from **July** -**October**. Hulett Farms grows some of their crops in a greenhouse.



Hulett Farms grows sweet corn on **45 acres** of land.



Hulett Farms also grows a **wide variety** of other crops.

Apples

Michigan is home to over **14 MILLION** apple trees.

Apples are the **largest** & **most** valuable crop grown in MI.



Michigan harvests **24 MILLION** bushels of apples each year.

Michigan apples are in season from **August** - **June**.



apples make **1** gallon of cider. **2,500** varieties of apples are grown in the United States.

> All of the U.S. produces **250** million bushels of apples each year.



An **apple blossom** is the flower that comes from an apple tree.

An apple tree takes at least **4 years** to start producing fruit. Most apples are still all HAND-PICKED.



McCallum's Orchard

McCallum's Orchard has been an operational apple orchard for **90+ years**.

As of 2023, McCallum's Orchard is now owned & operated by the **Radatz family**.

McCallum's Orchard welcomes visitors to pick their own fruit!

McCallum's Orchard is on **80 acres** of land.

> McCallum's Orchard makes their own **apple cider**!

Cucumbers

Michigan is the **#1** cucumber producing state in the U.S.

Michigan harvests over **450 MILLION pounds** of cucumbers each year.

Cucumbers can be grown without the use of soil – this is called **hydroponics**.



Cucumbers take **12 weeks** to produce fruit after being planted.



They are a fruit!

Cucumbers can grow up to **2 feet** long!

The large leaves on the cucumber plant provides **shade** for the developing fruit.



Bees are **essential** for the pollination of cucumbers.

Cherries

Traverse City, Michigan is known as the Cherry Capital of the World.

2 main types of cherries: **tart & sweet**.

Michigan grows **70%** of all **tart cherries** grown in the U.S.

Michigan is home to around **4 MILLION** tart cherry trees.

Cherry trees start to produce fruit **3** - **4 years** after planting.



Tart cherries are most often used for **baking**.

> Cherry trees can grow up to **33 feet** In height!

A typical cherry tree produces ~ 7,000 cherries/year.

A cherry tree can survive and produce fruit for around **100** years.

Cherry blossoms bloom on the trees in the **spring**.



An entire cherry tree can be harvested in just 7 seconds.



Michigan is home to **900+** dairy farms & **445,000** dairy cows.

11.6 BILLION pounds of milk is produced in Michigan each year.

Nearly 98% of U.S. dairy farms are family owned & operated.



Pretirie Farms



Sustainability is very important to Prairie Farms.



Their 600+ dairy farms are located in **16 states.** Prairie Farms is made up of **600+ family-owned** dairy farms.

Prairie Farms is a farmer-owned

cooperative that was started in 1938.

Each of the 600+ familyowned dairy farms is home to around **120 cows**.
