





90 MILLION acres of corn is harvested each year in the U.S.

Corn is America's **number 1** field crop.

Most countries outside of the United States calls corn **"maize"**. Most of the corn grown in the U.S. is grown in what is called the **"corn belt"** located in the Midwest.

Mushrooms

Tennessee produces over **21 MILLION pounds** of mushrooms each year.



Mushrooms are made up of around 90% water.

In total, the U.S. produces over **670 MILLION pounds** of mushrooms per year.

> Popular types of mushrooms: White Button, Crimino & Portabello.

Umami – a primary taste found in mushrooms.

These are all the **same** mushroom, just harvested at different ages.

Mushrooms do **NOT** require sunlight to grow. Some mushrooms stay underground for **YEARS** waiting for the conditions to be just right to surface.

Scientists have classified **2,189** mushrooms as **edible**.

Did you know mushrooms are **not** considered a plant? They are a **FUNGUS**.



Fungi are the **LARGEST** life form on earth.

Soybeans

The U.S. produces around **4 BILLION bushels** of soybeans each year.

Seedless watermelon are most popular.








