Merchant's Garden uses an **aquaponics** system to grow their lettuce.



Arizona's dairy industry is currently the state's **largest agriculture commodity**.

AZ is home to just about **100** dairy farms.

Arizona's largest dairy farm has around 10,000 active milk cows.

Nearly **98%** of U.S. dairy farms are family owned & operated.

Holstein cows all have a unique pattern of spots!

1 cow produces around6 gallons of milk per day.

The reason milk is white is because it contains "casein" - a type of protein.

The U.S. produces ~227 BILLION pounds of milk each year.
