Tangerines

Florida is the **number 1 producer** of tangerines in the United States.

Florida is home to around **10,490 acres** of tangerine trees.

FOUR Main Types of Tangerines Grown in FL:

In Florida, tangerines are in **peak season** from October to mid-November.





- 1. Fallglo 2. Sunburst-3. Royal
- 4. Honey

Tangerine trees grow to be **10-15 feet tall**.

"Easy Peelers"Tangerines are easier to peel than most other citrus fruit.

Tangerines are known for their **BIRGHT**

orange peel.

1 tangerine tree can produce up to 7,000 tangerines per season.

Tangerine trees are **evergreen**. Out of all citrus fruits, tangerines are the most resilient to cold weather.

Cucumbers

Cucumbers rank 8th most valuable crop in Florida.

Cucumbers in Florida are grown either **outside** or in **greenhouses**.

Cucumbers can be grown without the use of soil – this is called **hydroponics**.

Cucumbers take **12 weeks** to produce fruit after being planted.

Cucumbers can grow up to **2 feet** long!

Lafayette and Okeechobee are Florida's leading dairy counties.

Florida is home to around **125,000** dairy cows.

Breeds of Dairy Cows:

- 1. Ayrshire
- 2. Brown Swiss
- 3. Guernsey
- 4. Holstein
- 5. Jersey
- 6. Milking Shorthorn

Holstein cows all have a unique pattern of spots!

1 cow produces around 6 gallons of milk per day.

The reason milk is white is because it contains **"casein"** - a type of protein. Florida produces about **300 million** gallons of milk/year.

Nearly **98%** of U.S. dairy farms are family owned & operated.

> **ALL 50 states** have dairy farms!

The U.S. produces ~**227 BILLION** pounds of milk each year.
