

An apple blossom is the flower that comes from an apple tree.


An apple tree takes at least 4 years to start producing fruit.

90 MILLION acres of corn is harvested each year in the U.S.



Corn is America's **number 1** field crop.

Corn is considered a **vegetable**, **fruit** AND a **grain!** An ear of corn
ALWAYS
has an even number of rows.

There are around

800

kernels on each ear of corn.



Most countries outside of the United States calls corn "maize".

Most of the corn grown in the U.S. is grown in what is called the "corn belt" located in the Midwest.



West Virginia is home 5,000 dairy cows.

75 MILLION pounds of milk is produced in West Virginia each year.
